WHAT YOU NEED TO BRINGTO YOUR TAX APPOINTMENT

- All income statements, such as W-2's, 1099's, Schedules K-1, Proof of unemployment compensation
- Social Security Cards or Individual Taxpayer Identification Numbers (ITIN) for all those listed on the tax return
- Valid picture ID for taxpayer and spouse (Driver's License, State ID, Passport)
- Copy of prior year tax return (when possible)
- Bank account and routing numbers for direct deposit
- Intake form received in the mail, or can be found on our website www.gatewayeitc.org
- Proof of child care expenses
- 1098 mortgage interest and/or real estate tax receipt
- 1098-E student loan interest
- Forms 1098-T from educational institutions
- Form 1095-A (proof of health insurance from Marketplace)
- Form 5498-SA showing HSA contributions
- Form 1099-SA showing HSA distributions
- Notice 1444, Your Economic Impact Payment
- Parcel number (Illinois homeowners only)
- Anything else that says "Important Tax Document"
- If married filing jointly both spouses must be present to sign

ALL TAXPAYERS

WHEN APPLICABLE

Every taxpayer's situation is unique. It is impossible to list all the items one must bring in for a tax appointment for every type of tax situation. When in doubt, bring the item in.

Appointments are restricted to one person if filing single, two for couples filing a joint return.

Restrictions and closures will likely happen during the season.
